REPORT OF ENHANCEMENT OR UPGRADE OF SENSITIVITY OF TECHNOLOGY OR CAPABILITY (SEC. 36(B)(5)(C), AECA)

(i) Purchaser: Government of India (ii) Sec. 36(b)(1), AECA Transmittal No.: 19–30

Date: July 26, 2019

Implementing Agency: Air Force Funding Source: National Funds

(iii) Description: On July 26, 2019, Congress was notified by congressional certification transmittal number 19–30 of the possible sale, under Section 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act, of C–17 follow-on support, including spares and repair parts; support equipment; personnel training and training equipment; publications and technical documentation; support and

test equipment; U.S. Government and contractor engineering, technical, and logistical support services; and other related elements of logistics and program support. The estimated total program cost was \$670 million. There was no Major Defense Equipment (MDE) associated with this sale.

This transmittal notifies additional non-MDE follow-on support equipment, including aircraft components, parts, and accessories; Precision Measurement Equipment Laboratory (PMEL) calibration; and additional sustainment support, as previously notified. The estimated total cost of added non-MDE articles and services is \$130 million. The total estimated case value will increase from \$670 million to \$800 million. There is no MDE associated with this sale.

(iv) Significance: The proposed sale will allow India to maintain and operate its C–17s in support of military operations, humanitarian assistance and disaster response, and other operations, thereby promoting interoperability, and regional security efforts.

(v) Justification: This proposed sale will support the foreign policy and national security objectives of the United States by helping to strengthen the U.S.-India strategic relationship and to improve the security of a major defensive partner that continues to be an important force for political stability, peace, and economic progress in the Indo-Pacific and South Asia region.
